FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

TO THE RESPONDENT: Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises
430 South Garden Avenue
Roselle, IL 60172

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 10-40 of the Illinois Business Brokers Act of 1995 [815 ILCS 307/10-1] (the "Act"), the Secretary of State issued a Summary Order of Revocation on September 20, 2018 effectively revoking the registration of Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 10-40 of the Act Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises had 30 days from the date of that Order to request a hearing. Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises failed to request a hearing within the prescribed 30 days.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 10-40 of the Act, Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises' failure to request a hearing shall constitute an admission of any facts alleged in the Summary Order of Revocation and shall constitute a sufficient basis to make the Order final.

COUNT I

FAILURE TO RENEW REGISTRATION

The grounds for such proposed actions are as follows:

1. Respondent Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises (“Zaplatich”) is a Business Broker located in the State of Illinois, and has the last known address of 430 South Garden Avenue, Roselle, IL 60172.
2. Section 10-20(a) of the Act requires Illinois Business Brokers to annually renew their registration with the State of Illinois.
3. Section 10-20(b) of the Act states *inter alia* that an application for renewal must be accompanied by a filing fee in the amount specified in subsection (a) of Section 25 of this Act, and shall not be returnable in any event.
4. On February 6, 2018, the Illinois Secretary of State received Respondent Zaplatich’s renewal application and a \$400 check representing the renewal fee and late fee. The \$400 check was processed by the Illinois Secretary of State on February 15, 2018.
5. On March 15, 2018, the Illinois Secretary of State received notice that Respondent Zaplatich’s check had bounced as his account had insufficient funds to cover the \$400 check representing the renewal fee.
6. The Illinois Secretary of State has made numerous attempts to inform Respondent Zaplatich, through emails and mailings to his last known address, to inform him of this deficiency and provide him ample time and opportunity to resolve this issue.
7. To date, Respondent Zaplatich has not responded to any communications by the Illinois Secretary of State or has paid the renewal fee owed.
8. By virtue of the foregoing, Respondent Zaplatich has violated Section 10-20(b) of the Illinois Business Brokers Act of 1995.
9. Section 10-40(a)(2) states, *inter alia*, that the Secretary of State may deny, suspend or revoke the registration of a business broker if the business broker has violated any provision of this Act.

Final Order of Revocation
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NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


Respondent **Michael Anthony Zaplatich d/b/a Zaplatich Ultra Enterprises'** registration as a business broker in the State of Illinois is hereby **REVOKED** in the State of Illinois.

Delivery of this Order or any subsequent notice to the designated representative of any Respondent constitutes service upon such Respondent.

NOTICE: Failure to comply with the terms of this Order shall be a violation of Section 10-55 of the Illinois Business Brokers Act of 1995, as amended, 815 ILCS 5/1 et seq. (the "Act"). Any person or entity who fails to comply with the terms of this Order of the Secretary of State, having knowledge of the existence of this Order, shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.

This is a Final Order subject to judicial review pursuant to the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations of the Act (14 Ill. Admin. Code, Ch. I, Sec. 130.1123. Any action for judicial review must be commenced within thirty-five (35) days from the date a copy of this Order is served upon the party seeking review. Mailing of this Order to the Respondent or representative of record constitutes service of the Order.
