NOTICE OF HEARING

You are hereby notified that pursuant to Section 11.E of the Illinois Securities law of 1953 [815 ILCS 5] (the "Act") and 14 Ill. Adm. Code 130, Subpart K, a public hearing will be held at 69 W. Washington Street, Suite 1220, Chicago, Illinois 60602, on the 29th day of August, 2019, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, before , George Berbas, Esq. or such duly designated Hearing Officer of the Secretary of State.

Said hearing will be held to determine if the registration of Respondent Eric J. Felgenhauer as a register representative will be subject to a suspension or revocation in accordance with 8.E(1)(o) of the Illinois Securities Law, as amended ("Act"). Imposition of fines not to exceed \$10,000 against the Respondent for each violation of the Act described below; entry of orders of public censure; and charging costs of the investigation and all reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees and witness fees, in accordance with Section 11.E(4) of the Act.

The grounds for such proposed action are as follows:

1. Respondent Eric J. Felgenhauer ("Respondent") is a natural person with a last known address of 912 Butterfield, CIR E, Shorewood, Illinois 60404.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Illinois Department of Securities, Secretary of State ("IDS") as a registered representative since August 9, 2001.
3. Respondent is employed by Farmers Financial Solutions, LLC. as a registered representative since May 2001.

COUNT I

FAILURE TO PAY ANY TAX, PENALTY, OR INTEREST ADMINISTERED BY THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE

1. On or about July 5, 2017, the IDS sent a letter to the Respondent via certified mail notifying the Respondent that he had failed to effectively respond to the Illinois Department of Revenue's ("IDR") collection action, notice of intent letter and warning of the possible negative effect on his registration. Respondent was required to explain the situation, and Respondent's efforts to resolve it, in a notarized affidavit to the IDS within 10 business days of the date on which the letter was delivered.
2. On or about July 14, 2017 the Respondent sent the IDS a letter and notarized affidavit that was in response to the letter we sent on July 5, 2017. Respondent specifically stated that he would begin making monthly payments to the IDR on July 18, 2017 and planned on paying the remaining balance by the end of 2017.
3. On November 11, 2018, the IDS sent an additional letter to Respondent's last known address via certified mail notifying Respondent that he still had an outstanding tax assessment with the IDR and failed to file all the required tax returns to the IDR. Respondent was notified that his license as a salesperson was at risk for revocation if the IDS did not receive a RELEASE from the IDR within 30 business days.
4. The IDS did not receive a release from the IDR within 30 business days of the November 11, 2018 letter or any time thereafter.
5. To date, Respondent failed to pay the final assessment of his individual income taxes and failed to file all the required tax returns to the IDR.
6. By virtue of the foregoing, the Respondent has committed a violation of Section 12.D of the Act.
7. Section 8.E(I)(g) of the Act provides that the registration of a dealer may be suspended or revoked if it has violated any of the provisions of this Act.
8. Section 8.E(I)(o) provides that the registration of a salesperson may be denied, suspended or revoked if the Secretary of State finds that such salesperson has failed to file a return, or to pay the tax, penalty or interest shown in a filed return, or to pay any final assessment of tax, penalty or interest, as required by any Act administered by the Illinois Department of Revenue, until such time as the requirements of that Act are satisfied.
9. Section 11.E(4) of the Act provides, inter alia, that the Secretary of State, after finding that any provision of the Act has been violated, may issue an order of censure, charge costs of investigation, and impose a fine not to exceed \$10,000 for each violation of the Act

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10. Section II.F(1) of the Act provides, inter alia, that the Secretary of State may suspend or revoke the registration of a salesperson and impose a fine for violation of the Act after an opportunity for hearing upon not less than 10 days notice given by personal service or registered mail or certified mail, return receipt requested, to the person or persons concerned.
11. By virtue of the foregoing, the Respondent is subject to a fine of up to \$10,000 per violation, an order of censure, and an order that suspends or revokes his registration as a salesperson in the State of Illinois pursuant to Sections 8 and 11 of the Act.



Code 130) ("the rules"), to file an answer to the allegations outlined above within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this notice. The answer and all other pleadings and motions must be filed with the Illinois Securities Department by addressing them to:

A failure to file an answer within the prescribed time shall be construed as an admission of the allegations contained in the Notice of Hearing and waives your right to a hearing. Furthermore, you may be represented by legal counsel; may present evidence; may cross-examine witnesses and otherwise participate. A failure to appear shall constitute default. Unless the Respondent has upon due notice moved for and obtained a continuance.
